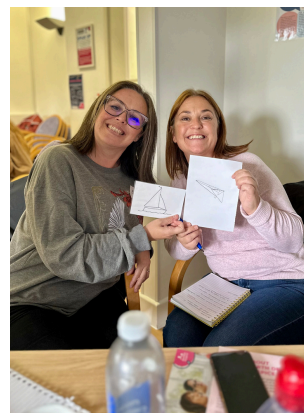


# AT NORTH DEVON HOSPICE WE ARE LOOKING FOR PATIENTS AND CARERS TO TELL THEIR STORY!

## Advance Care Planning

Do you have a story when more planning in advance with your healthcare professional could have improved the end for your loved one? Has there been a moment where it was completed well and had a lasting impact?

## Recognising Dying

Do you have a story when death was not recognised soon enough and the impact this had on you? Or do you have experience of when recognising death and talking about it early enough really helped you and your loved one?

## Enhancing Communications

We thrive on helping to improve communication here at the hospice and would welcome any stories around good or bad communication skills that you have experienced

## Teaching Skills
